What is FSAA?

FSAA stands for Full Scene Anti-Aliasing.

This is a filtering process designed to eliminate stair-stepping effects that can occur at low resolutions and are also known as 'jaggies'. This function works by calculating the image at a larger resolution (1.5x, 2x or even higher) than the gaming resolution and then rescaling the image to the display resolution. This blurs pixels at the edges of lines in order to make the transition from one color to another smoother.
