

Will my new motherboard function properly with boards equipped with RADEON™ chipsets?

Graphics boards equipped with a RADEON™ AGP processor are compatible with AGP 2.0 standards and should therefore function without any problems with the majority of motherboards conforming to this standard. Some modern motherboards require AGP drivers to be installed in order to support AGP. In general, these drivers are supplied when you purchase your motherboard. Contact your motherboard manufacturer to find out whether any updates are available or download them from your motherboard chipset manufacturer's website.
