## How can I manually assign an IP address to my computer on a system running Windows XP?

To configure your computer's IP address on a system running Windows XP, you must go to your system's *"Control Panel"*. To do so, click *"Start/Settings"* and then *"Control Panel"*. In the Control Panel, click the *"Network and Internet Connections"* link, then *"Network Connections"* (or simply double-click *"Network Connections"* in the Control Panel).



Right-click your network connection whose "Device Name" is "Hercules Wireless G..." and select "Properties".
